JUDICIARY RED/YELLOW CARD:

Reports and Actions for Yellow / Red Cards:

Yellow Cards:

Referees are to report* all yellow cards within 24 hours to:

- 1) Club Managers (see reporting procedures)
- 2) Stay Fit Soccer Director JerryLustofin@gmail.com (see reporting procedures)

No judiciary action will be necessary for a single yellow card, unless the offense involves racism, harassment, verbal discrimination, or physical abuse on or off the field.

SFS Director has discretionary decisions.

Accumulation of Yellow Cards:

3 yellow cards in a season, will result in a one game suspension. SFS Director has discretionary decisions.

SFS Director will notify the player and the Club manager within 48 hours of the consequential action. The SFS/ Judiciary committee may be consulted.

Red Card:

Referees are to report* all red cards to the Club Manager and to the SFS Director with in 24 hours. All Red Cards will be subject to Judiciary review by the SFSJC within 48 hours of the report. JerryLustofin@gmail.com

The Judiciary Committee has 48 hours to inform the player and Club Manager of the action that will be given for the offense of a Red Card.

An appeal must be filed with the SFS Director within 24 hours.

The final decision of the consequence for the Red Card will be informed by the SFS Director to the offending person within 48 hours.
